Stay and Play 'to go'

Rainbow Rice

Rainbow rice is always popular at Stay and Play! This really easy, relatively mess-free, open-ended activity will also feature in this month's session.

You will need:

- 1 cup of dry rice per colour
- Unscented hand gel
- Coloured paint
- Zippy bag or lidded container
- Baking tray
- · Various pots, scoops, spoons, sieves, funnels for play
- Larger container for play (cat litter trays or shallow storage boxes are perfect)

Method:

- Add one cup of rice to your bag/container
- Add one small squirt of hand gel
- · Add a squirt of paint (no more than a teaspoon)
- Zip up the bag/ensure the lid is on firmly
- SHAKE! Until all the rice is covered and the paint has dispersed
- Spread out on a baking tray to dry
- Add a few pots, scoops, spoons and play!
