- Find a safe place to stand a good distance from fireworks and bonfires.
- · Keep your children close to you at all times.
- · Make sure that little ears are protected-firework displays tend to be loud and a little overwhelming.
- Earmuffs/defenders can reduce dangerous levels of noise.
- Wrap up warm; little hands, feet and heads feel the cold very quickly.

Edible Fireworks!

You Will Need:

- · Bread sticks snapped in half
- · White chocolate buttons
- Shimmer sugar/ shiny sprinkles/sugar balls
- Popping candy (to give an extra special sensory experience!)
- 1. Melt a bag of white chocolate buttons either the old fashioned way or by zapping them in the microwave for 20 seconds and stirring through.
- 2. Lay out the bread sticks, melted chocolate, sugar and sprinkles in a little series of bowls, and invite children to start by dipping the end of a stick into the chocolate to cover it.
- 3. Then dip in and pick up the various sprinkles, creating a sparkly effect! Leave them to set by placing in a glass or cup, or, have a little taste straight away! Pop! Fizz! Wow
