

Handprint Dragonfly

Dragonflies are magnificent insects and this activity lets you create your very own. Maybe you could take yours out when your next on a walk and see if you can find any dragonflies.

You will need:

- Card
- Watercolour paints
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Jumbo lolly stick
- Googly eyes
- Pipe cleaner
- Glue

To create, you need to:

1. Watercolours are a fun way to explore colour but you can use any other paint as well. Paint a piece of paper or try out a technique where you add watercolour paint to a spray bottle of water and spray over the piece of paper to cover it and create a funky design.
2. After the paint has dried, trace around your hands and cut them out.
3. Then you can paint the lolly stick. Once this has dried, you can stick on the googly eyes and then stick the body onto the handprint wings.
4. Glue on the pipe cleaner and curl at the ends.
5. You can then attach some string if you like and hang it up or even attach to a magnet to stick on the fridge.
