

Paint and Ziploc Art

Have you read The Mixed-up Chameleon book? It's a really fun book about a chameleon that wishes it could be more like the other animals it sees but soon decides it would rather just be itself. This is a fun activity you can do based on the book but you can also do lots of other animals and shapes as well.

You will need:

- Large Ziploc bags
- Paint
- Masking tape
- Sharpie pen
- Googly eyes (if you want)

To create, follow these steps:

1. Draw your animal or shape onto the Ziploc bag using the Sharpie pen and stick on some googly eyes if you wish. (Tip: If you need help drawing an animal, find a Chameleon Colouring Page, for example and trace over the shape onto the transparent bag)
2. Squirt a little blob of paint into the bags, you can do as many or as little as you like.
3. Seal the bag really well and try to get pockets of air out.
4. Tape the sides of the bag down onto the table, a window or any other surface.
5. Use your fingers to start playing with the paint and creating your masterpiece - mess free!
6. You don't have to draw an animal or shape onto the bag, you could just have fun with the paint in the bag
