

Yarn Wrapping

This is a fun activity to do to practice fine motor skills and the results are amazing. You can create many pieces such as this spring tree, or the letter of your name, animals and so much more.

To make the spring tree, all you need is:

- Cardboard
- Yarn
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Tape
- Tissue paper

To create, you need to:

1. Cut out your tree shape from cardboard and create small slits around the scallop edge of the tree to create extra places to hold the yarn in place.
2. Tape the end of the green yarn to the back of the tree and wrap around. Tape the end piece to the back of the cardboard as well to finish.
3. Repeat step 2 for the trunk using brown yarn.
4. Crinkle up small pieces of pink tissue paper and stick them on the tree using tacky glue.
5. You can use different colours and make different trees for different seasons as well such as snowflakes for winter.



You can use this same method to create other pieces and you can try different amounts of yarn to cover the cardboard fully. You could also stick other materials to your design or use textured yarn to create effects.
