


Spooktacular Halloween Fun

On top of all the joy of dressing up in your best scary costume and trick or treating, Halloween is a great time to tap into your creativity and create some fang-tastic crafts.

Ghost Handprint Banner


You will need:

- Coloured paper
- Black pen/crayon
- White pen/crayon
- Scissors
- Glue stick



Method

- 1. Trace around your child's hand on the coloured paper.
- 2. Cut the handprints out (Tip: Stack the coloured pieces of paper on top of each other and hold in place with a paperclip if you want to cut them all at once)
- 3. With the fingers pointing down, children can now draw on the scary faces.
- 4. Fold a sheet of white paper in half lengthwise. Open up and cut along the crease. Attach the two lengths of paper together with a glue stick end to end.
- 5. Repeat step 4 with black paper and trim off 1 cm from the length.
- 6. Glue the smaller black piece of paper on top of the white piece of paper to create your banner and write Happy Halloween on it.
- 7. Finally, stick your child's handprints to the bottom of the banner.
- 8. Witch one will you do/boo?



Black Cat Pumpkin

You will need:


- 2 large pumpkins
- Black paint
- Material for the bow
- Green paint or glow in the dark

- Small pink pom pom
- Witch hat
- Black foam
- Self-adhesive black foam



Method

- 1. Remove the stem from the bottom pumpkin
- 2. Paint both pumpkins black
- 3. Stack 1 pumpkin and top and steady it
- 4. Paint the cat eyes on
- 5. Glue the pink pom pom on for the nose
- 6. Cut the self adhesive foam into 6 strips for the whiskers and stick on
- 7. Cut cat ears out of the black foam and attach to the witches hat
- 8. Tie the fabric around the neck to create a bow



Tissue Box Monsters


You will need:

- Tissue boxes
- Paint
- Googly eyes
- White card
- Pom poms
- Lolly pop sticks
- Glue



Method


- Paint the outside of your tissue box in any colour or pattern
- 2. Once dry, do the same for the inside of the box
- 3. Cut out some teeth and stick on
- 4. Create your creepy monster however you want by adding pom poms, eyes, feathers, paint splodges and so much more



Monster Rock!

Method

This is a super easy and fun activity. All you need to do is find some rocks and paint them. Once dry, you can stick on some googly eyes and draw funny or scary faces.



Stamping Fun

You will need:

- Potatoes
- Carrots
- Any other fruit and veg
- Toilet roll tubes
- Paint
- Googly eyes
- Pipe cleaners
- Paper / Card





Method

- 1. Cut the fruit and veg in half or a halloween shape
- 2. Dip the fruit and veg into paint and stamp onto the paper.
- 3. Once dry you can add fingerprint eyes, googly eyes or anything else.
- 4. For the spider, cut 4 legs on each side of the toilet roll tube. Once finished you can even decorate the tube into another spider by painting it all black and sticking on some googly eyes
